B. Eligible operators of Motorized Carts or Personal Transportation Vehicles:

- a. Any licensed vehicle operator.
- b. Person holding learners permit if accompanied by licensed vehicle operator.
- c. Person who is 12 years old if accompanied by parent, grandparent or guardian.

C. Authorized roads of travel for Motorized Carts or Personal Transportation Vehicles:

- 1. Motorized Carts may only be driven on designated public roads, right-of-ways or other public property of the City.
- 2. The designated public roads shall include all public roads within the jurisdiction of the City (excluding US 25/301 GA 23/144) which have a speed limit of 35 miles per hour or less.

NOTE: GA Highway 23/144 from the intersection of Tillman and Barnard Street to the intersection of Church and Barnard Street shall be considered designated public road for travel of motorized carts and personal transportation vehicles.

- 3. Designated right-of-ways or other public property includes all public right-of-ways and public property of the City.
- 4. Motorized carts and personal transportation vehicles shall not be operated on the sidewalks at any time with the exception of:
 - Residents of Lakeview may travel on the sidewalk East side of US 301/25 from Oliver Lane to Banks Street.
 - Residents of Deloach Lane and Camelot Subdivision may travel on the sidewalk West of US 301/25 from Deloach Lane to Gordon Street.
- 5. No motorized cart or personal transportation vehicle may cross any street, road or highway which is a part of US Highway 301/25 (Veterans Boulevard) or State Highway 23/144 (Barnard Street) with the exception of the below listed crossings:
